



Dual Credit/Early Admission Application

Hill College participates in a program of dual credit/early admission for qualified students who have not yet graduated from high school. A public school official (counselor, vice principal, or principal) must approve this form before a student will be eligible to enroll under dual credit/early admission. Students must meet the criteria below to qualify for dual credit/early admission:

- Must be in the eleventh or twelfth grade. Tenth graders with exceptionally high academics are allowed to take classes, ONLY when the school faxes or mails the Sophomore-Level Approval form to Enrollment Management (The form is found in the Dual Credit link on the www.hillcollege.edu website.).
- Must demonstrate college-readiness by placement testing (THEA or Accuplacer) or exemption from placement testing with appropriate alternative test scores (TAKS, SAT, ACT).
- Must meet all regular prerequisite requirements designated for the desired course.

As a dual credit/early admission student, please be aware of the following:

- The class load of a high school student shall NOT exceed two college credit courses per semester w/o completion of the Permission to Take More Than Two Courses form, completed by a high school official (Refer to this form in the Dual Credit link on our homepage, www.hillcollege.edu).
- Upon acceptance to Hill College, the student will be conditionally admitted. Once the student completes high school requirements for graduation, a completed high school transcript with the date of graduation must be sent to our Enrollment Management office. An official Hill College transcript will not be issued until an official high school transcript is received.
- Students failing to maintain at least a 2.0 GPA will be placed on academic probation and must be counseled by the Hill College Director of Admission and Records prior to enrolling in subsequent semesters.
- Your signature on this form gives Hill College permission to release your dual credit college course grades to your high school upon request from the appropriate high school official. By your signature, you also agree to only register for courses specifically approved by your high school official.
