

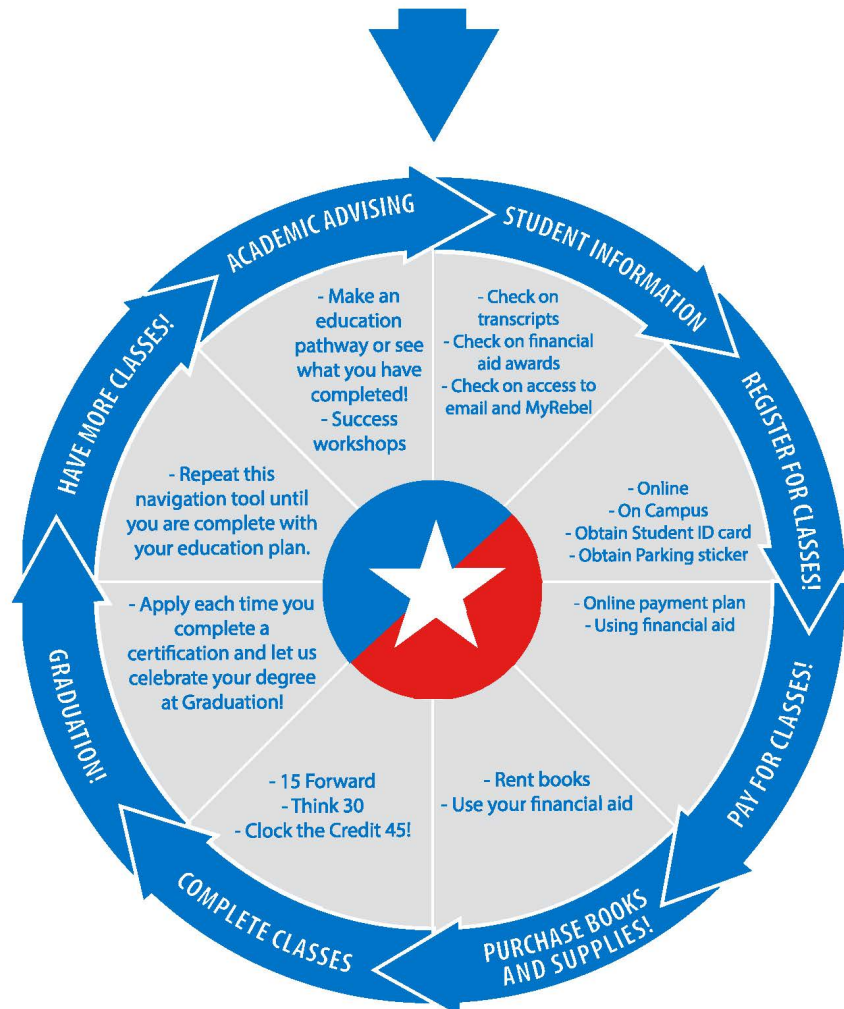


GEOLOGY ASSOCIATE OF SCIENCE
