Kids Kollege Classes

Art for Little People (1st-4th)

Do your kids like to express their creative side? This course will encourage each student to explore his/her own unique, artistic style. Students will have a chance to explore a variety of art. Wear clothes you can get messy in!

Baseball Basics (1st-8th)

This course is designed to teach the kids the fundamentals of baseball with key emphasis on throwing, fielding, hitting & base running. Kids should wear comfortable clothes and tennis shoes and bring a glove and bat. Students will be playing outside, please provide sunscreen and a hat/visor.

Basketball Bombers (1st-8th)

This course is designed to teach the kids rules and techniques of the game including shooting, dribbling and passing. Kids should wear comfortable clothes and tennis shoes.

Bead Bonanza (1st-5th)

Beads are as old as human existence. This class will explore a little history of beads and how they have played a role in society, trade, culture and ornamentation. Students will have the opportunity to make a few bead creations!

Career Paths (5th-8th)

Have you ever wondered what life would be like as a veterinarian, teacher or nurse? This class will lead you to information on different careers and how to plan for those careers. Students will have the opportunity to calculate potential earnings for their future career. Your future is waiting!

Etiquette 101 (5th-8th)

This is a co-ed class that will equip young children with the social etiquette, table manners and personal style to face challenges with confidence.

Kitchen Science (6th-8th)

This is cool science using everyday items found in your home. The curious-minded will have fun with science experiments one could do at home. We hope you don't mind getting a little messy! Class is limited to 10 students.

Learning History at the Museum (6th-8th)

This class will take students through time as they tour the Texas Heritage Museum galleries and collections, go on scavenger hunts and play the Texas Independence computer game.

Math Blasts (1st-5th)

This is a unique out-of-school learning opportunity for children to explore, to question, to reason and to discuss sound mathematical topics suited to children's level and interests.

Power It Up! (1st-8th)

In this course, students will express creativity through the use of computers. Students will have the opportunity to work on power point presentations.

Reading Enrichment (1st-5th)

This class will motivate your child to read by teaching them it can be fun. Students will work cooperatively to accomplish many projects related to books. These activities will enrich your child's mind and will have a strong emphasis on concepts such as characters, setting and problem solving.

Rodeo Roundup (1st-8th)

This beginning class will cover the fundamentals of roping techniques. Students will have the opportunity to learn on a bucking barrel and learn goat tying. Students will need to wear tennis shoes and comfortable clothes. Be sure to wear sunscreen.

Snack Attack (1st-4th, 6th-8th)

Learn the importance of good nutrition and physical activity through interaction and snack creation. Students will actively engage in activities while learning about good health.

Softball Superstars (1st-8th)

This course is designed to teach the kids rules and techniques of softball. Kids should wear comfortable clothes and tennis shoes and bring a glove and bat. Bring a ball and a helmet if you have them. Students will be playing outside, please provide sunscreen and a hat/visor.

Tennis (1st-8th)

This course is designed to teach kids the rules and techniques of tennis. Kids should wear comfortable clothes and tennis shoes. Students will be playing outside, please provide adequate sun screen and hats/visors. Bring a tennis racquet if you have one!

Writing with Creativity (1st-4th)

Let your mind run wild! This course will encourage students to let their creative juices flow as they learn to develop their writing skills. Students will be given journals to write in daily and will receive feedback on how to improve their writing skills.
