Students will not be required to take additional core curriculum courses at the public transfer institution unless the Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board has authorized an expanded core curriculum at that institution. If all components of the core curriculum are satisfied, the statement "core complete" is noted on the transcript. Be sure to refer to the Education Plan and consult with program/faculty/academic advisors so the right choices for core curriculum courses that will transfer smoothly to the chosen four-year institution.

Students enrolled in an associate degree program at an institution of higher education must have an education plan on file with the institution once the student has earned a cumulative 30 semester credit hours.
