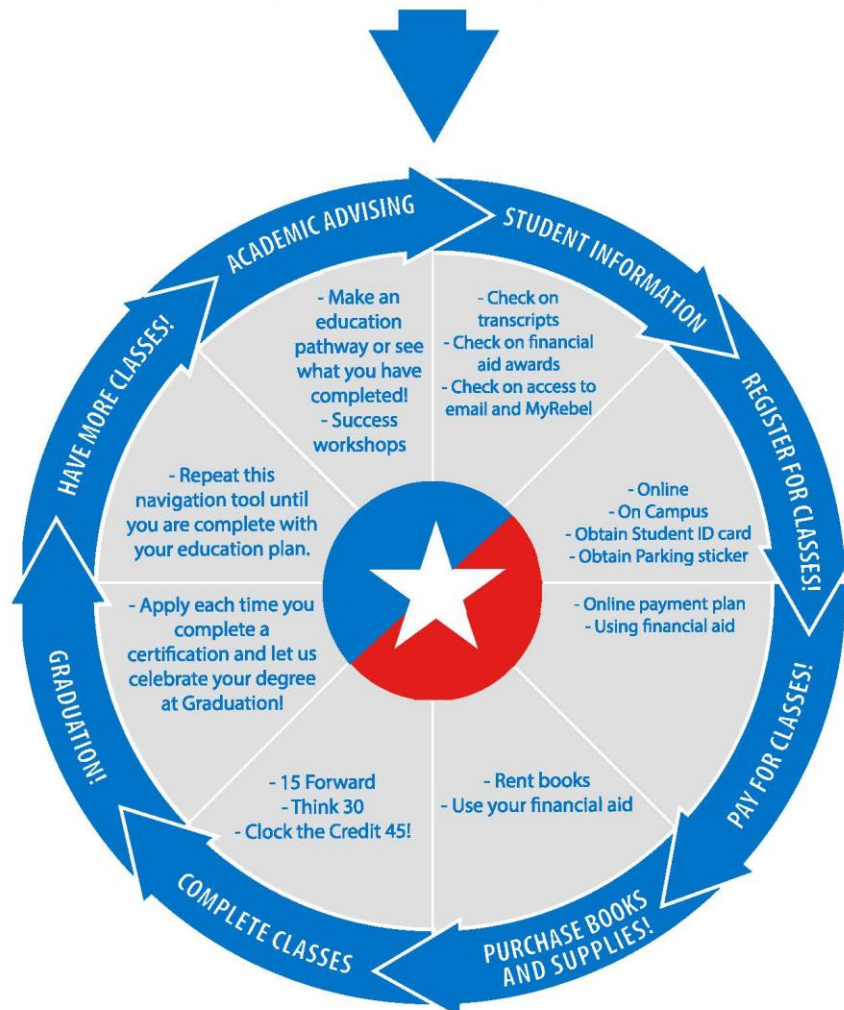




## BEHAVIORAL SCIENCE ASSOCIATE OF ARTS
