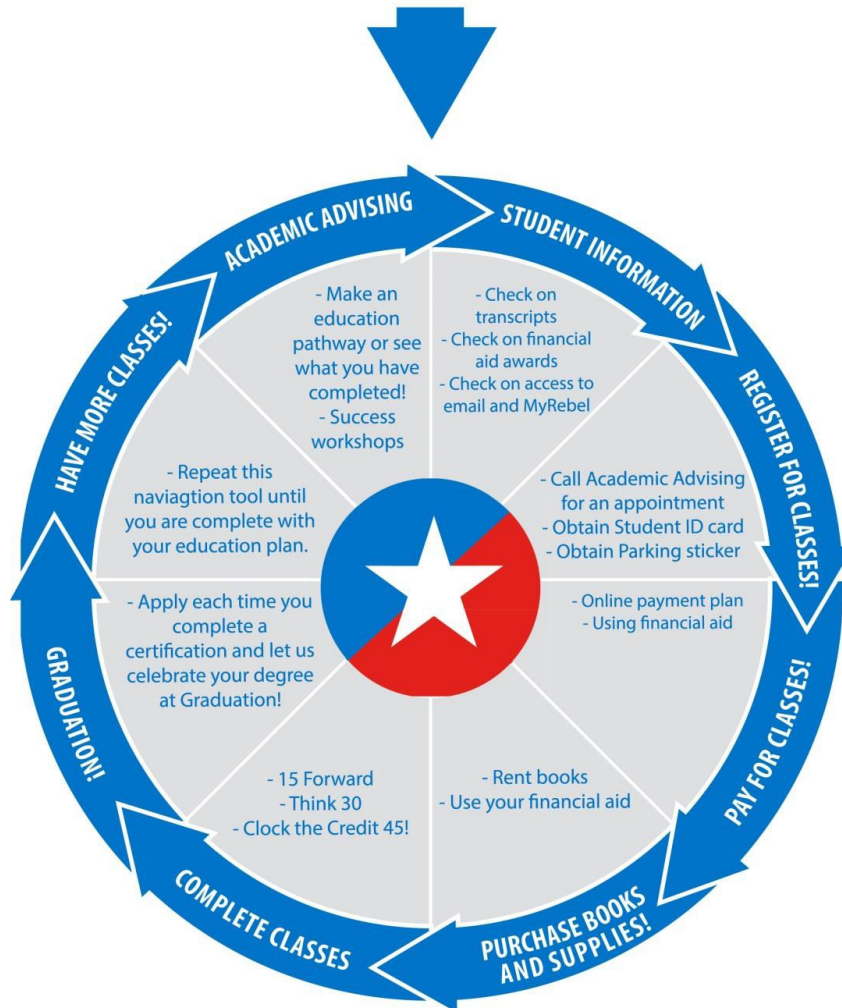




Business Management AAS Education Plan
