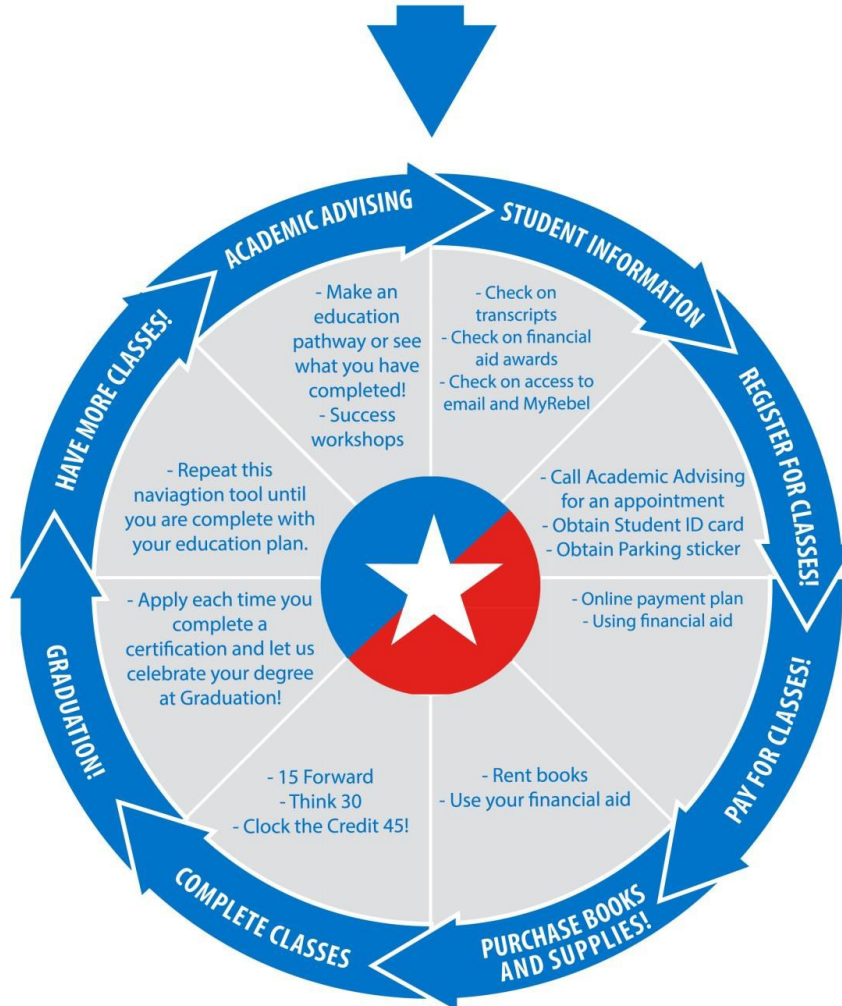




Welding Technology AAS Education Plan
