

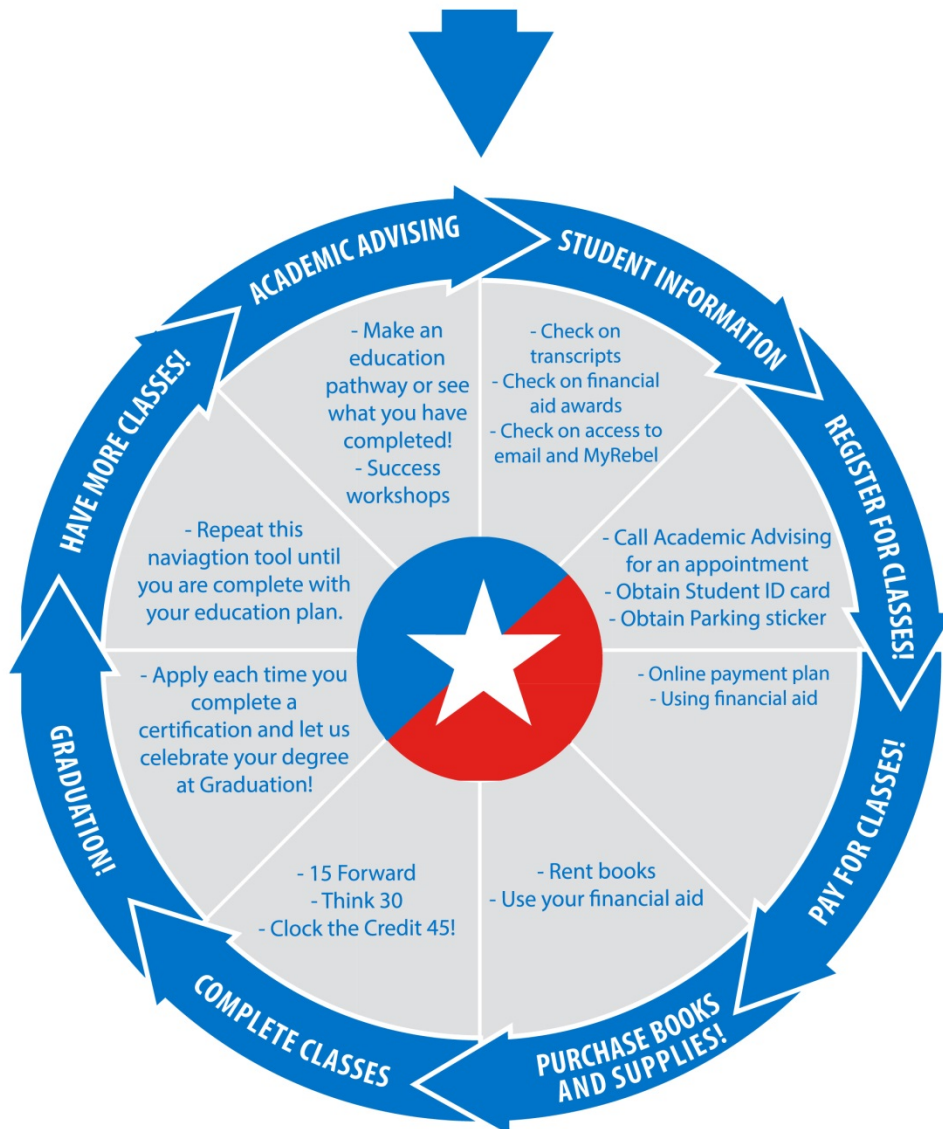


## DRUG AND ALCOHOL ABUSE COUNSELING
