

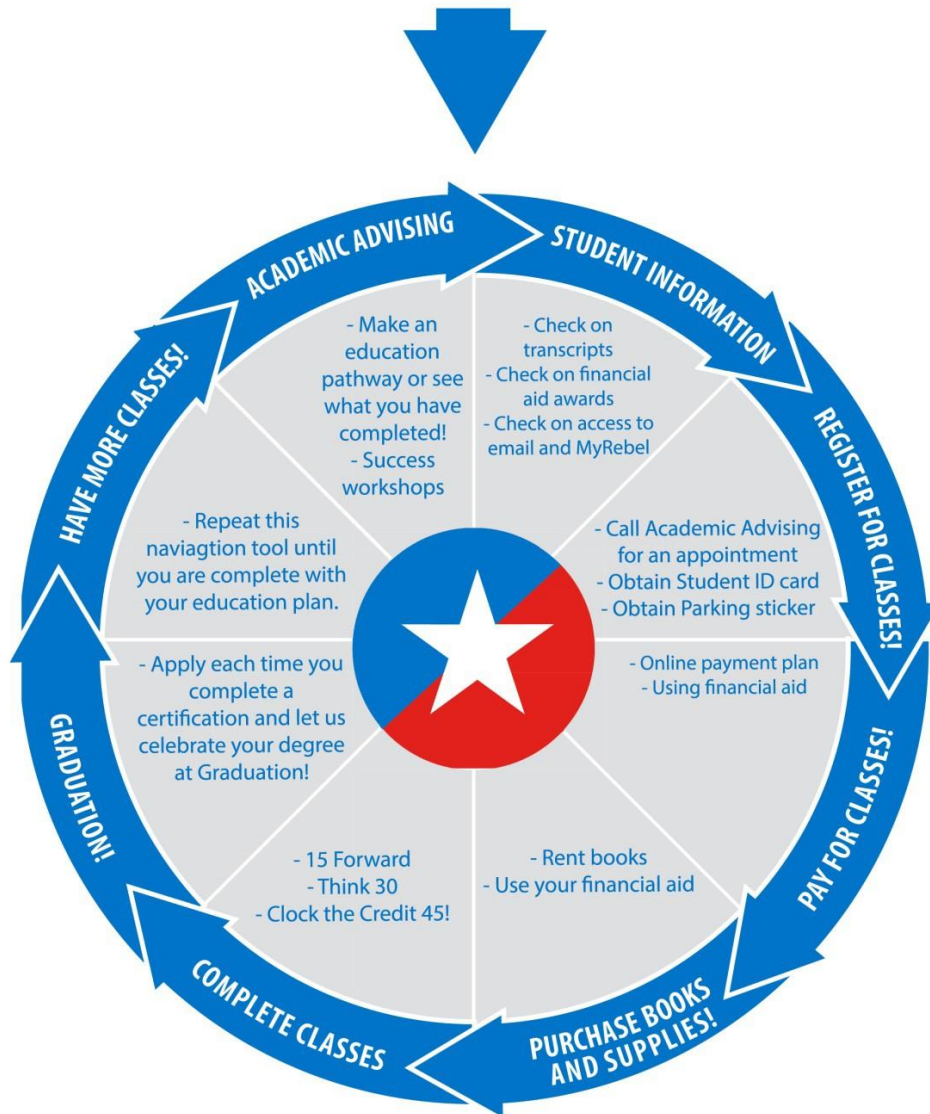


CRIMINAL JUSTICE, ASSOCIATE OF APPLIED SCIENCE
